An Unexpected Arrival...

1966 - I was born 3 months premature to an unwed mother in her Van Nuys apartment, weighing only 2.5 lbs. I was considered "unadoptable" due to a tumor in my windpipe. An emergency tracheotomy was performed so I could breathe...but GOD had a Plan!



1967 - My first 13 months were spent in a state

rehab hospital, including 6 months in an

incubator. I made no sound when I cried! I just shook the bars of my crib until rescued. The doctors gave no hope for a normal life...but GOD had a Plan!

Finally a Real Family!

I went from a very sick baby to a healthy kid in 7 years. I somehow taught myself to speak in gasps by forcing air past the tracheotomy tube. The Clarks endured 14 surgeries with me and I was finally healed. I was blessed with a safe Christian home and loving parents for 8.5 years. Sadly, my stay with the Clarks was soon to end...but GOD had a Plan!

1967-75 - Terry & Pauline Clark decided to

bring a foster child into their home (along

with their 3 kids). Miraculously, the day the

social worker toured their home; they were

baby-sitting the boy at left with braces.

I lost the only family I ever knew at 9 years old.

1975-82 - The Clarks decided to adopt me, but first needed my bio-mom to release her rights. Shockingly, she refused to sign and pulled me from the Clarks. I moved into a house with complete strangers! As sad as this was for the Clarks and me... God set into motion a series of Divine Appointments. During this time, I discovered art and would meet a number of friends that would change my life.

Into the Mouth of Hell (& Hollywood)

My new life was very different from the stable Clark house. I ended up living in 16 different places, had 3 step-dads, started drugs at 12, and was arrested at 13 for dealing. At 14, I lived in the same house as my dealer and was part of a stealing/drug-dealing group of kids. At 15

I moved to Hollywood and met my new best friend Chris Weber, founding quitarist of Guns n' Roses (GnR)...but



My Guns n' Roses Story

1982-86 - I now lived in the Hollywood Hills with my Mom and her new boyfriend. I met Chris Weber in 10th grade at Fairfax High School, home to

famous rock bands like GnR, L.A. Guns, Mötley Crüe, and Red Hot Chili Peppers...

I only lived in Hollywood for one year and finished 11th and 12th in a different city. In 12th grade, Chris picked me up and drove me back to Hollywood to introduce me to his new band: AXL, which later became Hollywood Rose, and then GnR. I grabbed my camera and shot Chris, Axl Rose, and Izzy Stradlin in front of a billboard on Sunset boulevard. Izzy climbed up a 50 foot billboard and spray painted: "AXL Rocks". These photos are some of the earliest of the band and are featured in many books and magazines including Rolling Stone. Amazingly, in 2018 their label used my photos for the cover on their re-release of the original demo CD and Vinyl LP.

1984 - After graduation, Chris called and said: "Dude, I scored a house, do you want to move in?" I moved sight unseen into the GnR party house in the Hollywood Hills. The house was the second home to Axl Rose, Izzy, and Steve Adler. We also opened our doors to a colorful cast of druggies, groupies and freaks of all kinds. I was a heavy partier at this time but miraculously was not snared by serious drug addiction. Almost all my closest friends became junkies! ...it was devastating...thankfully,

Discovered at Hollywood & Vine

1986 - During this time I worked at a luggage store at Hollywood & Vine. One day, a 27 year old named Rob Langer came in looking for a briefcase. Rob mentioned that he had just placed an ad for a "runner" at the CSUN Career Center.

This was huge DIVINE APPOINTMENT: I boldly (stupidly?) told him to cancel his ad because he just found his guy! Rob looked at me and said: "you're hired".

New Life at Hollywood & Vine

Crazy... I was just hired in Commercial Real Estate but still had no idea what the job was! On my first day, the boss took me out and bought my first (and only) suit and tie. I became the leasing agent for the two high rise buildings at the corner of Hollywood & Vine. In 2 short weeks, I went from funky black clothes and spiked hair in a luggage store, to a killer office with a secretary (who looked like Whitney Houston)! My newfound professional appearance started sobering me up on the outside long before I got sober on the inside.

Like Father Like Son 1987 - After a year of well funded partying, I went to a movie called Like Father, Like Son. In the movie, Dudley Moore (dad) and Kirk Cameron (son) switch places. Dudley's character looked like an adult in a suit outside but inside was an irresponsible 16 year old.

> I felt God saying to me... "That's you!" I had taken God's blessing of my birth/ survival and this new career and nearly destroyed both through reckless living.

"I'm Going Clean"

I went home shortly after that and announced that I was going clean! Soon after that, I came home to find my roommate moving out and taking all the furniture and appliances with him! God knew I was not strong enough to stay clean on my own and used this incident to remove temptations to party. I had no bed or furniture...but GOD had a Plan!

Out of the blue, a friend from my drug dealing years called and asked if I knew of a room for rent (I was literally standing in an empty apartment). He then said, "I've got one problem... I have a whole house FULL of furniture!"

Surprisingly, my new roommate had turned his back on drugs and was the positive peer pressure I needed to stay clean. He eventually introduced me to the person that took me to church.

God Makes His Move...

1988 - On Mother's Day I got dragged to a very large church. I was shocked to see normal and even "cool" people there. What amazed me was that in a room of 3000 people, the words of the pastor were speaking specifically to me and my circumstances: I had achieved much of the success (through real estate) that the world said would satisfy, but was now painfully aware how truly empty and unfulfilled I was. I realized I was a sinner in need of a savior. After 4 weeks I made a decision and met with a counselor. I thought that God couldn't forgive me due to my dark past. The guy responded that God rescued him from serious sexual addiction and the Lord could forgive my past as

What is Sin, Faith & Repentance?

I grew up in a Christian home and heard a lot about Sin. I also heard repeatedly that you need Faith ("I Believe") and need to Repent ("I'm Sorry") to be saved or have a personal relationship with the Lord.

Recently I found a clearer definition: Sin means missing God's target for you. Faith means putting your full weight on Christ. This is risky dependence and belief that will cost you something. Repent does not just mean "I'm Sorry," but is a full **180 degree turn** from my normal habits and behaviors. This means having a desire to seek God's direction in all areas.

With the counselor, I prayed and proclaimed my belief that Christ died for my sins and rose again. I then asked Jesus to come into my heart and be my Savior and Lord (meaning I would live for Him and seek His will for my life through His Word: the Bible). I admitted that I was a sinner and repented. I then accepted Christ's forgiveness through Faith. For the first time in my life, I was not afraid of death! The Lord answered my prayer that day and my life began at that moment...but GOD still had Plans for me.

1989 - God even managed to use my Guns n' Roses past for **His Plan**. In 1989, GnR was the biggest band in the world and it led me to share this story for the first time.

1990 - Two years later, even though a committed Christian, I was continually haunted by bad choices I'd made. I finally confided to a friend and expected him to reject me. Instead, he shared a verse that set me free:

Romans 8:1 "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of Life set me free from the law of sin and death."

My eyes opened to the fact that my past, present and future

sins were paid for (forgiven) by Christ's death and resurrection. I began to heal and several months later met my wife Laura! I believe God waited for me to deal with my issues before I started dating.

We Survived COVID!

2021 - Laura and I just celebrated our 30th anniversary and thankfully survived a global pandemic! The foundations Americans place their hope in have been shaken. Now, I rest knowing that my firm foundation (faith in Christ) can't be shaken even though the world crashes and burns.

...thankfully, GOD still had a Plan.

My past was one of fear, selfloathing, greed, jealousy and Bottom: Me, Joni Eareckson Tada (Google Her story) and my wife Laura. I was a sick baby in the hospital with Joni 50 years ago and she did a radio show on my story.

gossip. Although I still struggle in many areas, I now experience love, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness and self control. Life in Christ is not easy or always happy... but I now have the inner joy that comes from a relationship with Christ.



First Bloo

Five rough early demos by Axl Rose's pre-Gn'R band - hidden in this cash-in release - show his appetite for stardom. By Greg Kot

Hollywood Rose / The Roots of Guns n' Roses / Deadline Music ★★



On the first song of this 1984 demo tape, the erstwhile William Bailey of Lafayette, Indiana – soon to be world famous for raising his goblet of rock as W. Axl Rose – not only demonstrates

he's a first-rate screamer but also a prophet: "I'm doing nothing on borrowed time . . . /I make my living killing time."

Rose has become better known in the last decade for what he hasn't done: most notably, completing the still-unreleased album Chinese Democracy. But the five songs documented on The Roots of Guns n' Roses remind us why Axl once mattered: an ill wind from the Midwest, ripping up the Sunset Strip. Straddling the fence between punk and glam, in scarves and leather, Rose and his fellow Indiana expatriate Izzy Stradlin put together the band that would eventually morph into the more spectacular, and star-crossed, Guns n' Roses.

The original demos on this album are thrillingly underproduced, from an outfit that's more about outlaw kicks than the MTV-courting spectacle of Gn' R. With their

hyperventilating tempos and staccato guitars, "Killing Time" and "Shadow of Your Love" have more in common with L.A. punks the Germs than with Iron Maiden. "Anything Goes" runs on spite even as Rose fights for his right to be as kinky as he wants to be. "Rocker" ends with Rose out-cackling the Wicked Witch of the West - or was that Bon Scott? - as she melts down in The Wizard of Oz. The self-evident "Reckless

Life" revs up like a Harley, then plunges into traffic with blinders on. "Don't need your advice," Rose screams as if he's kissing off Lafayette for the final time.

The only problem with these demos -Hollywood's answer to the Sex Pistols' infamous Spunk bootleg - is that they weren't left alone. Instead, gratuitous remixes and overdubs turn a potentially classic nineteen-minute EP into a bloated fifty-nineminute cash-in. Sunset Strip semicelebrity Tracii Guns lays on some extra guitar, and ex-Cinderella drummer Fred Coury beefs up what else? - the kick drum on a handful of tracks. All they do is magnify just how brilliant the raw and still-squirming originals remain.
